

HOME GROUP QUESTIONS: 10/18/20



Who was the unlikeliest person you know who became a Christian? How did it happen?

1. What does Acts 9:1-2 indicate about Saul's attitude toward Christ and toward His followers?
2. How do you think Saul felt when confronted by Jesus (vv. 4-6)? What might he be thinking about during those three days of blindness in light of his previous activities?
3. How did the Lord first get your attention? Was it in some dramatic way like this or a quieter, more natural form?
4. While Saul's conversion experience is not the norm, what aspects of his conversion should be true for every believer?
5. Why is it important for Christians to have a clear testimony?
6. Take some time to reflect on how and when the Lord called you to Himself. What were the circumstances and who were the people involved? How did you see the Lord move in you?
7. Is there someone in your sphere of interaction that seems really hardened toward the Gospel? Pray for a softening in this person's heart. Then pray for an opportunity to reach out to or serve that person in a meaningful way. Take the opportunity when it comes.
