

HOME GROUP QUESTIONS: 11/15/20

1. We started a new series this week titled Unmatched. What stood out to you the most from the message?
2. The text for the sermon is Hebrews 10:1-25. Based on what you heard from the message, how would you summarize in your own words what this passage is communicating? Why is this passage so crucial for Christians to understand? According to this passage, what should be our response to the work of Jesus? (see 10:19-25) Notice these instructions are given as a corporate response (rather than just an individual response). Why do you think this is important?
3. How might Home Groups serve to “stir up one another to love and good works...”? (Hebrews 10:24) Share about an experience when you felt “stirred up” to love and good works as a result of time spent in Christian community. What made this significant?
4. Eugene spoke in the message about the wonderful ministry of Billy Graham. As effective as Billy Graham was in ministry, he was only human. Some would falsely view Billy Graham as a mediator between us and God. From the passage in Hebrews we realize there is no need for a human mediator- we have the one & true mediator, Jesus. What causes people to place too much hope in human leadership? What are ways people might wrongly cling to the faith of others in order to find peace with God?
5. According to Hebrews 10, why was the Old Testament sacrificial system ineffective? Why could it not produce being in right standing with God? From this passage what did Jesus accomplish that the sacrificial system could not accomplish? What are “human” ways that people try to earn favor with God that prove empty and ineffective? What’s the answer to this problem? Why do people continue to try and earn salvation by human effort?
6. How have you seen Jesus differently as a result of hearing this week’s sermon? What makes Jesus unmatched?
7. What will be a few things that will stay with you this week?
